The Prairies


Alberta, Saokatchewan and Manitoba are called the prairie provinces. But, only the southern parts of these provinces lie within the true prairie.


The word "prairie" in French means meadow. A prairie is an open grassland with few trees. The land is mainly flat with some low, rolling hills. The Canadian prairies loarm the northern edge of a wast grassland that stretches south almost to the Gulf of Mexico.


The North American prairie region is in the middle of the continent, far from large bodies of water and blocked by mountains to the west. There is not enough rain to support teers, but grasses can survive the long, dry and often hot periods. So can hardy prairie flowers like daisies and violets.

For many centuries the prairie was home to the Aboriginal peoples who followed the great hends of bison across the grasolands. With the aniwal of Luropean settlers, the bison herds were destroyed and the native prairie grasses were replaced with graves for cattle and grasses grown for grains.
